

Thomas Gaberel is Assistant Professor of Neurosurgery at Caen-Normandy University, France. He is a neurosurgeon specialized in cerebrovascular and skull base surgery, with a PhD thesis in Neurosciences. During his training, he did a research fellowship in Boston with Prof. Lo and Dr. van Leyen (MGH/Harvard University). He is a member of Prof. Denis Vivien' team (Caen, France), where he is involved in experimental research in animal models of stroke and brain MRI. His scientific interest focuses on the pathophysiology of aneurysmal subarachnoid haemorrhage, intraventricular hemorrhage and cerebrospinal fluid physiology. He is the principal investigator of a large randomized controlled trial, the FIVHeMA trial, evaluating the impact of intraventricular fibrinolysis after aneurysmal subarachnoid hemorrhage.
