

Prof. Dr. Hänggi is Chairman, Division of Neurosurgery at University Medical Center Mannheim, Ruprecht-Karls-University Heidelberg, Germany. He is a neurosurgeon, scientist, researcher and a recognized expert on brain hemorrhage, including delayed cerebral ischemia (DCI) after subarachnoid hemorrhage, eloquent gliomas, skull-base tumors and minimal invasive spinal procedures. For the past 15 years, his research interest has focused on improving patient outcome after brain hemorrhage, with a specific focus on developing a cure for cerebral vasospasm and DCI. He has published over 200 peer-reviewed articles, authored and edited multiple textbooks, and has spoken at many international and national conferences.

Additionally Prof. Dr. Hänggi is an active member and expert of multiple international and national Neurosurgical- and Neurointensive Care Societies, in detail responsible for definition of guidelines, conducting international studies and teaching aspects. During his career, he received multiple national and international awards.
